IV Background

To realize sustainable development, China has formulated the basic national strategy of “energy-saving, environmental-friendly, social harmony and sustainable development” on the basis of the scientific outlook of development. The government has explicitly put forward the goal of shaping economic growth pattern featuring low energy consumption, low pollution, low investment and high efficiency. Therefore, developing new energy is a top priority of China.

Increasing attention is drawn to biofuels because of energy shortage, nuclear power safety issue and crude oil price hike. Represented by US, EU and Brazil, many countries has made biofuels the answer to energy issue, and has set up related development goals and supporting policies and measures.

How should China, confronting food shortage, balance the development of biofuels and food supply? What are the prospects, potential difficulties and corresponding solutions of biofuels in China? This workshop is to answer these questions. It will provide an important platform to understand the current situation and future development of biofuels in China, as well as to learn beneficial international experience.
